Graeme Drum is proving to be a really energetic artist, one who is breathing the fresh air of a new dawn into the world and new age genres, he set his marker with the incredible album *Eclectic* and here he is again, making an even bigger statement on the world stage with the single **Sand Storm**, which also features the talents of Ahmed Al-Badr.

This new era of an eastern flavour is so addictive to listen to, the tabla and overall percussion may remind you of the end of the last century, with artists like *Thornton and Ramzy*, but now Drum, with his latest musical efforts is staking a claim of his own, and bringing an energy of utter power and vibrancy as he does so.

Sand Storm is a truly forceful composition, creating and manifesting images of a desert caravan, under a blistering sun; guitar and percussion are king in this realm and Drums creation, if there were any fairness in selection, would find this piece of music gracing a soundtrack to a movie.
